Financial Responsibility: (Who pays for what?)

<u>The New Mexico State Chapter</u> pays for housing for two nights, double occupancy, plus the official Convention meals (one lunch, 2 dinners) for:

The New Mexico State Chapter also pays for:

- All official Convention meals for two delegates from each chapter. If chapter delegates fail to attend Convention, the chapter is responsible for reimbursing the state for meals ordered.
- Housing for Past State Presidents, double occupancy.

<u>Local Chapters</u> pay for housing for their two delegates for two nights.

- Delegates are required to stay in the official Convention hotel.
- Each chapter should reimburse its delegates for transportation and any meals not paid for by the New Mexico State Chapter.
- Payments for meals not canceled by the March 15th deadline become the responsibility of the local chapter.

Convention Registration:

- All members of convention MUST register online. The registration fee for PSPs is \$25.00.
- All visitors and guests attending, must register online.
- On-site, visitor registration is necessary. Visitor registration cost is \$5.00 and includes a program. Visitor and guest registration will continue throughout Convention.
- Registration packets for Members of Convention, Visitors, and Guests will be distributed from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Thursday, April 20, 2023, in the lobby outside the convention venue.
- Members of Convention must pick up their packets by 3:45 p.m. to be ready for the workshops that begin at 4:00 p.m.
- Visitors and Guests may register and pick up pre-paid meal tickets at any time during Convention.




